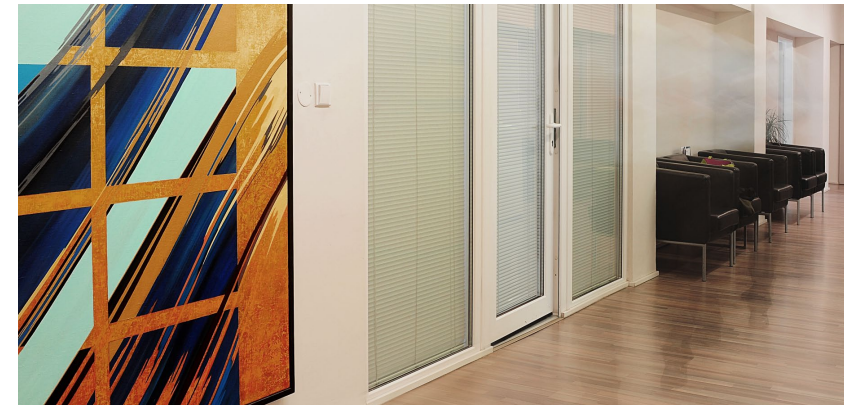
Our services are provided mainly in Czech, English and Slovak.

Areas of Expertise

Mašek, Kočí, Aujezdský provides complex legal advice in a number of areas of law. It handles the entire legal agenda for various companies and other business subjects and advises both commercial and non-commercial entities in individual cases and transactions. Our firm regularly produces specialist advice on specific legal issues or in relation to supplied documents. Our work often contains an international element or it involves the application of EU law. Our employees specialise mainly in the areas of law listed below. Mašek, Kočí, Aujezdský also provides escrow services regularly.

IT law, e-commerce and intellectual property

Software licensing agreements, terms of business for the distribution of software or for the running of website services or an e-shop, legal issues relating to information systems, distance agreements concluded in the context of online shopping, liability relating to software, GNU/GPL consultancy, know-how protection, protection of information, personal data protection, rights of an author and unfair competition on the internet, domain disputes, organisation of marketing competitions.

Commercial law

Corporate law

Formation, transformation, dissolution and winding up of companies, non-monetary contributions to registered capital, preparation of appointment and removal from function, changes of registered office, transfers of business shares and shares, other types of acquisitions, transfers of membership rights and obligations connected to the membership of a cooperative, increasing and decreasing registered capital, company mergers, splitting up of companies, alteration of the legal form of companies and transfer of capital to a member, preparation of general meeting or members' meeting minutes, application for entries in the Commercial Register, company dispositions, assisting foreign companies with running their business in the Czech Republic – setting up their structural units or subsidiaries.

Law of commercial obligations

Drafting contractual documents (including so-called innominate contracts), drafting terms of business, contracts for future contracts, emission of bonds, security of commercial obligations, debt management, dispute resolution, debt collection,

representation in court and enforcement proceedings, claims arising out of a breach of legal duties and obligations, commercial representation.

Civil law

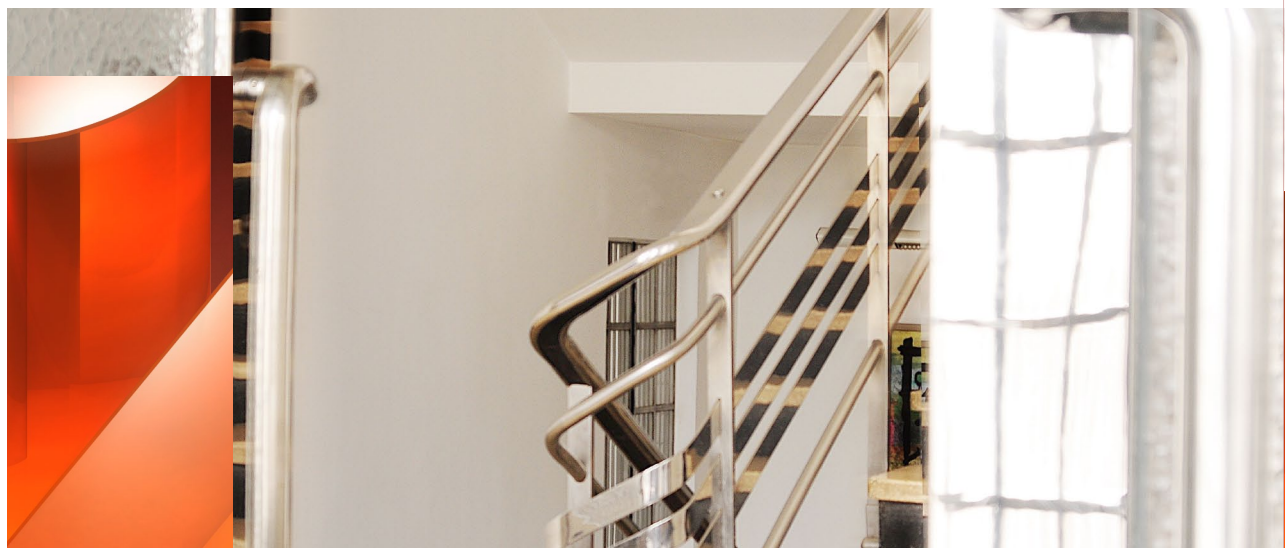
Proprietary rights including ownership disputes, termination and settlement of co-ownership, protection of personal rights of an individual, consumer protection, obligations (contracts, compensation for loss, security of obligations), inheritance law, representation before courts, remedial measures, enforcement and execution of judgments, arbitration proceedings.

Property law

Sale, purchase and gift of real property, proprietary rights to the property of another – liens and easements, legal relationships between the exchange of contracts and registration of title, issues pertaining to renting flats and commercial premises, construction law, advice on mortgages.

Personal and proprietary rights and their exercise, rights of performing artists, rights of a maker

of an audio or audio-visual record, licensing agreements, liability, claims arising from a breach of a right of an author, claims arising from a breach of a right related to the rights of an author, databases.

Trademark law

Registration of national, EU and international trademarks, representation in examination and opposition proceedings before the Industrial Property Office and the Office for Harmonization in the Internal Market, representation in proceedings for the invalidity of a trademark or relating to an application for the revocation of a trademark, representation before courts in trademark infringement disputes.

Criminal law

Legal advice prior to the start of a criminal investigation, criminal defence, erasure of a criminal conviction, conditional release from prison, decisions on good conduct in the probationary period, representation of the injured and advice to victims of criminal acts, preparation of a report to the police on the commission of a crime, complaints.

Administrative law

Administrative proceedings, representation before public authorities, electronic signature, organisation of consumer competitions, personal data protection, freedom of access to information, administrative offences and other administrative delicts, residence of EU citizens in the Czech Republic, registration of a provider of payment services of a small extent, saving of cookies, employment agency permits.

Employment law

Drafting contracts of employment and agreements to carry out work outside the scope of employment, drafting the internal regulations of an employer, changes to terms of employment, employee transfers, legal aspects of terminating employment, collective redundancies, wages and salaries, impediments to work being undertaken, liability for loss, workplace safety, discrimination, European Employee Council.

Family law

Pre-nuptial agreements, relations between spouses, divorce, parental responsibility, issues relating to the upbringing and maintenance of

a minor child, determination of fatherhood, adoption, settlement of marital property on the basis of an agreement or by a decision of a court.

Constitutional law

Constitutional complaints, right to a fair trial, protection of postal secret.



eAdvokacie System

To fulfil its aims and values, since 2003 Mašek, Kočí, Aujezdský has been using, as the only law firm in the Czech Republic, an online system of provision of legal advice. This online system is called eAdvokacie and it allows us to provide complex legal advice via the internet. The eAdvokacie system is used primarily as a web interface for the communication between a client and a lawyer by way of secure online communication, but also as a tool for a secure exchange and administration of documents and recording of payments. If the protection of confidential data is important to you, then you can rest assured that unlike common email, information provided to a lawyer will not travel via the internet unsecured.



THE EADVOKACIE SYSTEM IS USED PRIMARILY AS A WEB INTERFACE FOR THE COMMUNICATION BETWEEN A CLIENT AND A LAWYER BY WAY OF SECURE ONLINE COMMUNICATION.

How does eAdvokacie work?

Legal services are provided in electronic form by way of communication with an operator – a lawyer – in real time via a communication window as soon as a client has registered and logged in. During this online communication between a lawyer and a client, the nature of the legal issues is ascertained and the appropriate form of legal assistance is agreed. In accordance with this agreement, we will then draft the required documentation and upload it into the client's user interface, and carry out other tasks as required by the client. Once the documents are uploaded, the client is notified by e-mail. The client is then able to pay the fee for legal services via an online payment system or by card.

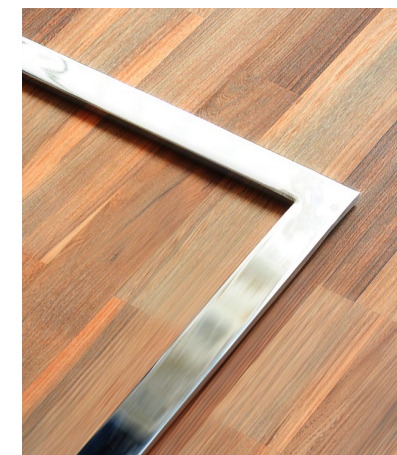


JUDr. Taťána Pazourková

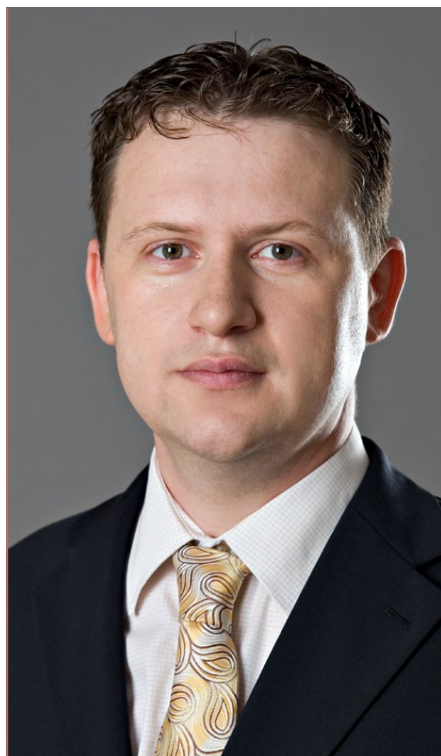

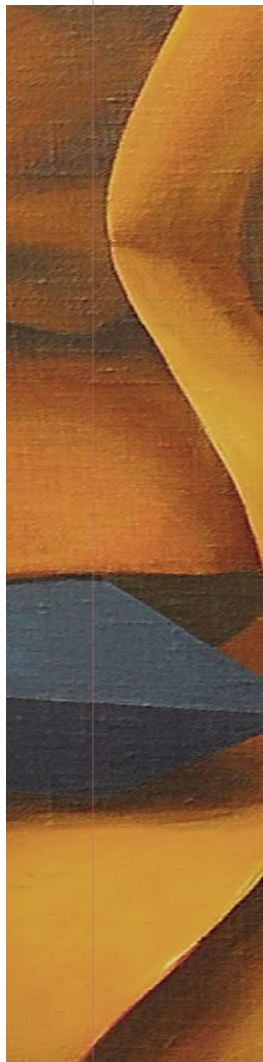
Mgr. Lenka Spiváková

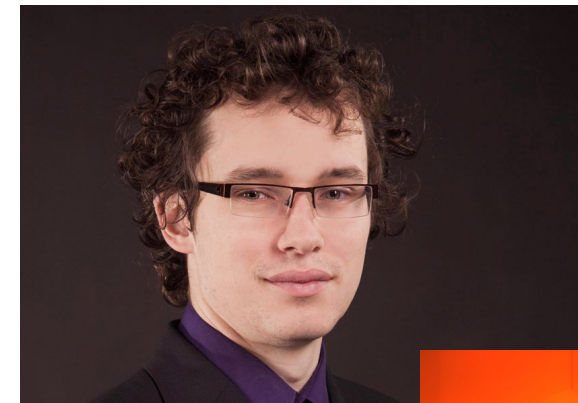
Mgr. et Mgr. Denisa Diepoldová

Lucie is the firm's administration manager. Lucie provides complex administrative support to the other employees of the firm.

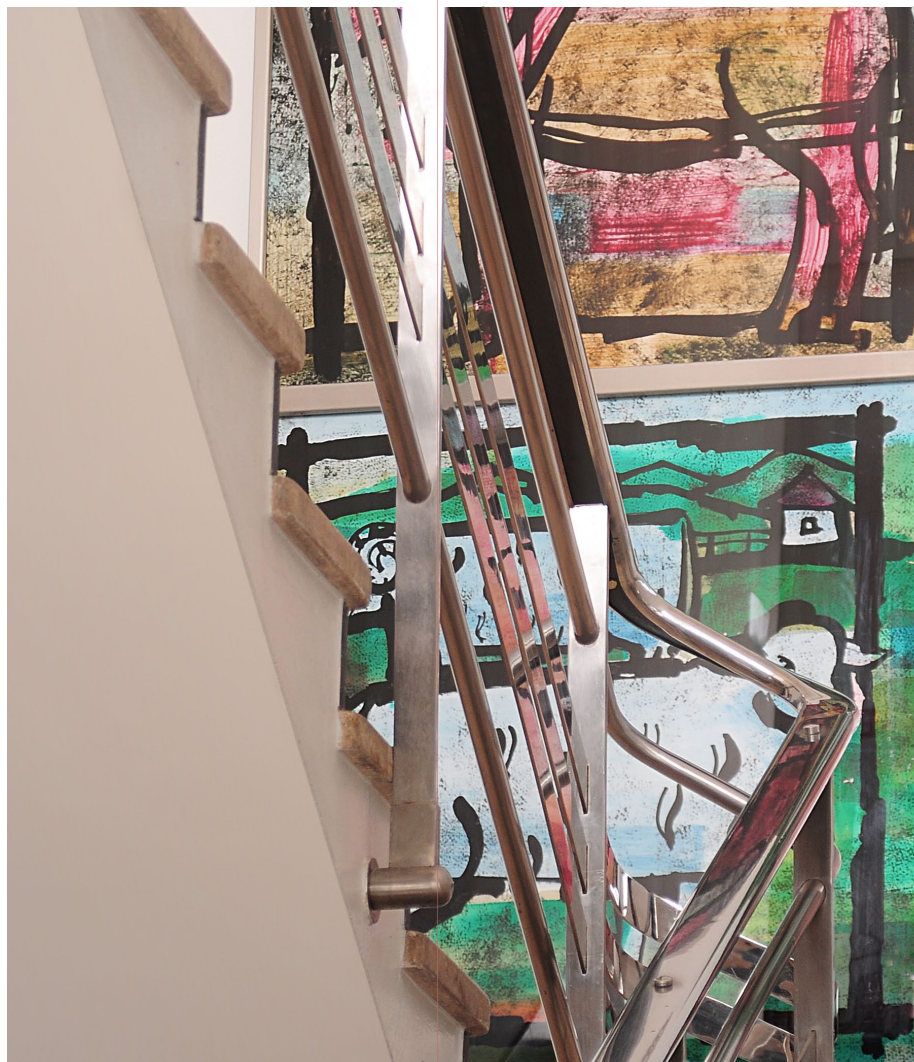

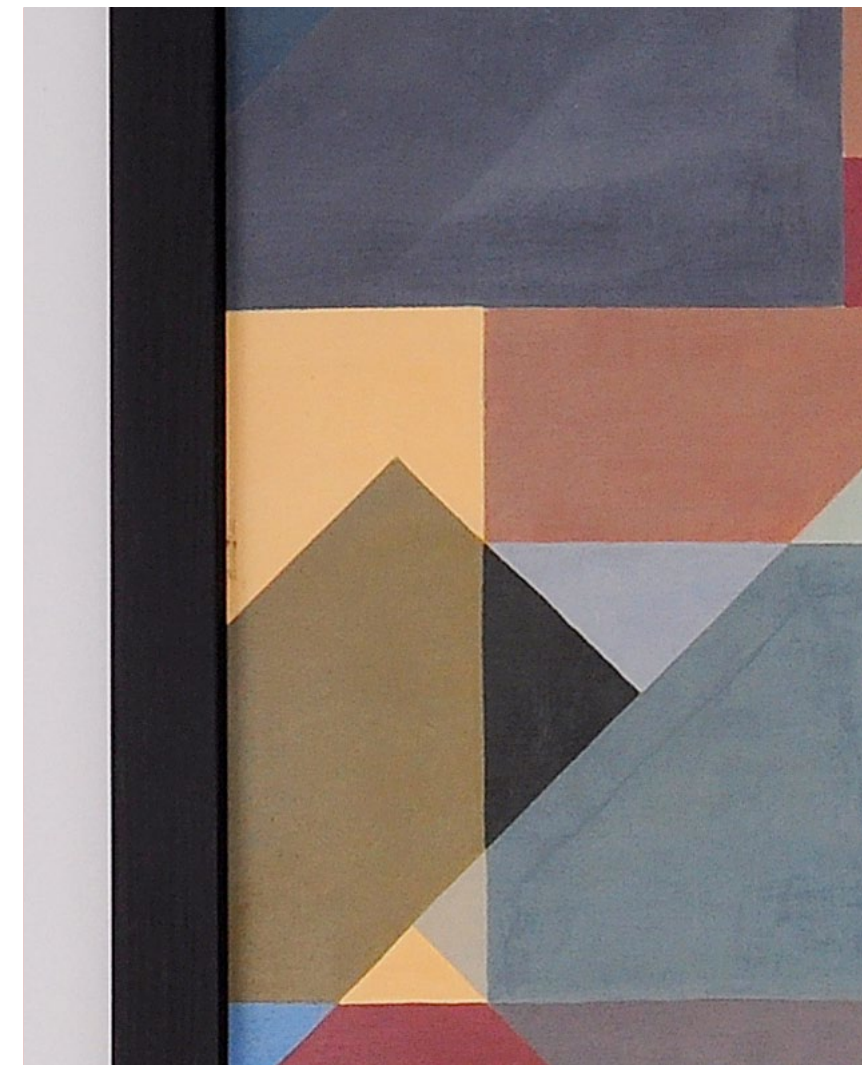
